Classroom Building Projects Update

We are now in Week 5 and I thought it appropriate to keep you all informed about the building upgrades in BC Primary.

The CET Property Manager, Don Ackland along with the CET architect are managing this project on behalf of the Christian Education Trust who provide the buildings for the College. Don reports that the plans for A Block have all been



approved by TCC. B Block is still being defined in terms of the exact specifications of the upgrade.

Provided temporary accommodation can be put in place for next term and a building team engaged, it is intended that A block will upgraded during

Term 2 and hopefully, B block in Term 3. The CET are investigating portable classrooms to house classes during the upgrade, rather than displacing another spaces like a hall or the library.

We obviously want these rooms to function very well in terms of learning spaces. The specifications for these buildings are being thoroughly worked through. The CET have engaged professionals to ensure that sound,

lighting and ventilation all meet or exceed MOE codes of compliance.

We will let you know of more developments as they come to hand.
