We are excited to see Rise Dance Company offering dance classes again at BC. So get in early and register for Term One classes.

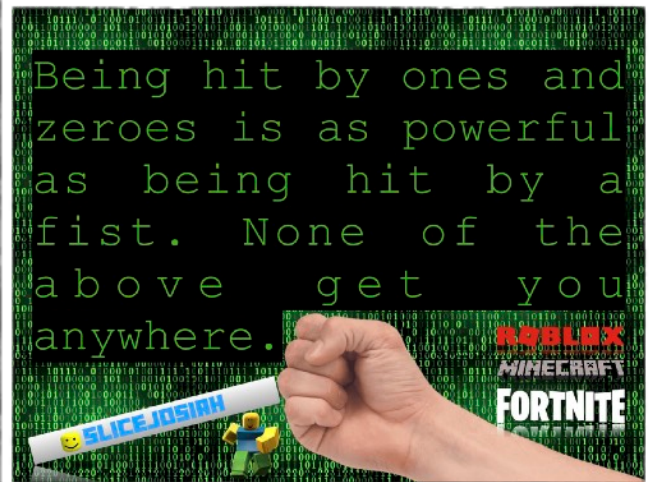
