Date: Wednesday 13th February Time: 5:00pm till 7:00pm BYO Picnic Dinner (BC is an alcohol free campus)



#### ATTENDANCE

There are many reasons why a child can be away from school. Some reasons, we have little control over, while others are due to choices we make. However, there is certainly a strong link between consistent attendance at school and student success. Inconsistent attendance and regular late arrival to school both make the learning process more difficult for children. While 100% attendance is ideal, anything over 90% is considered normal. However if attendance drops towards 85% it does become a concern.
