If you have walked through BC Primary recently, you will have spotted the construction work happening in and around B Block. Although we had significant delays getting through council, our contractors have been able to get started quickly and have made great progress. One of the significant aspects of this project is the laying of a concrete floor. This is no minor undertaking within an existing building, however the CET and BoT

have been committed to developing new learning spaces that are truely fit for purpose. Having a concrete floor is a real benefit when it comes to achieving the kind of acoustic results we are looking for. We are expecting the building to open in the middle of Term 3.

Strike Action - School Closed: Wednesday 29th May

You will be aware that teachers are due to strike on Wednesday 29th May because of the lack of progress in their contract negotiations. While not all staff across Bethlehem College are members of the unions, a significant majority are.

Accordingly, The Board of Trustees has decided to close the College for instruction for this day - Wednesday 29th May. This means that no supervision will be available, and all students must remain away from school on this day.

We are sorry for this inconvenience and disruption, as we know it will significantly impact some families. It is however, beyond the Board's control. Teachers haven't taken such action for many years and do it very reluctantly. Thank you in anticipation for your support in this matter.
