LOVING OUR KIDS ON PURPOSE

Dear Parents

The Loving on Purpose Parenting our Children' course is being offered in Term 3 on a <u>Tuesday evening and morning</u> over a period of 5 weeks.



This series is based on the work of Danny and Shari Silk, from Bethel Church. The course will be facilitated by Mr. Andrew Allen, Director of Pastoral Care and Counselling at BC.

Term 3 Dates: Tuesday 3rd August - 31 August (5 sessions)

Please note there is a morning session in the PAC Foyer area 8:45am-10:15am and an evening session, *7pm to 8:30pm. Venue: L block at BC.*

Any changes will be sent to participants. The course is hugely engaging, practical and biblically based.

Parent feedback from the course:

"We found the Loving on Purpose course so valuable. Not just for the depth of content and strategies to develop and grow an enduring love connection with our children, but as a reminder in our busy lives to preserve what is of utmost value – our family bond.

Taking the time out for only a few evenings to connect as a couple and reflect on how we can practically work out ways to promote a healthy family life, is time well spent."

There is no cost but providing a packet of nibbles when we have a cuppa would be appreciated. Other courses may be offered in Term 4, depending on expressions of interest.

Numbers are limited to around 12-14 and ideally (but not a pre-requisite), for both parents to attend.
