## A FEW REMINDERS:

### Uniforms

Thank you for naming your children's clothing - especially socks! Jerseys are fine indoors but we ask the children to not wear their outdoor jackets in the classroom.



### Illness

With the onset of the flu season we ask that you ensure children are not coming to school unwell. A reminder that students who have been vomiting/diarrhea need to be kept home for 48 hours afterwards.

### Before school Library use

Our Primary children are welcome to come to the Library between 7:30 and 8:10 am. While in the Library no devices are to be used.

Our teachers are continuing their professional learning journey around Writers' toolbox which is having a positive impact on the children's writing. I encourage you to talk with your children about what they are learning about different sentence types in particular. This school/home discussion is powerful in helping children learn deeply. Our partnership together is important to us all so thank you for your interactions with your children about what they are learning and with us also as we all support each other.
