






#### EPRO 8

#### Free Media App for BC Families



#### **Call for Nominations**

As per the letter emailed to you earlier this week, if your contact details have changed recently, please update these ASAP by signing into BC Community/Kamar via our website homepage. Changes need to be made by Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July. Thank you.



Every three years parent and staff board member elections are held. The principal is the Board's CEO and is responsible for the management of the school and the Board provides strategic governance. The Board includes the principal, one elected staff member, five elected parent members, one elected student member and up to four members who are appointed by the school's <u>Proprietor</u>. Board meetings are held once a month and follow a set agenda that is finalised by the Principal and Chairperson, with committee meetings held separately. Board members are required to read any reports/discussion papers sent to them prior to the meeting so that they are well informed and able to participate in decision-making. We ask that those who have prayerfully considered the role of Board Member consider being nominated for election <u>here</u>. For more information, the NZ School Trustees' Association has produced an informative booklet which outlines the responsibilities, role and make-up of school Boards (<u>Download NZSTA booklet</u>) and the role of the board is defined in its governance manual.
