BETHLEHEM COLLEGE CREST: EXPLANATION

In the centre is the CROSS, the foundation of the Christian faith. It speaks of the wonderful love of God in action for us all.

Top left is the open book, representing God's truth and wisdom in the BIBLE and in creation.

Bottom left is the MENORAH, representing the land and people of Israel, from which we derive our Christian faith and heritage. Top right is the DOVE, representing the Holy Spirit who lives within the believer giving life and power.

Bottom right is the CROWN and SCEPTRE, both representing the royal power and the authority of Jesus Christ who is our King and Lord.

The crest is in the shape of a SHIELD, representing the protection available to us from the Lord.
