It was fascinating to learn that Bumblebee Queens hibernate like bears over winter, sit on their nest of eggs like a broody hen, and go through metamorphosis like a butterfly as they transition from an egg to a pupa to a bee!

LIBRARY NEWS


The BC library will be closed 4-8 December and open again the week of 11th December for issuing of summer reading books to those who have signed up.
