### **FINANCIAL COMMITMENT**

Term 1 2025 Playing fees (based on 2024 but are subject to change)

Approximate Pre-season training fees: 10-14 students: \$9 per 1 hr session

15-20 students: \$6 per 1 hr session

#### Approximate season fees:

Years 7-13: \$195 plus pre-season training

Years 9-13 (Senior A Team): \$265 plus pre-season training\*

[If there are less than 8 players in a team, fees may increase to cover league entry fees and pool hire for training.]

\*The Year 9-13 Summer tournament team going in Term 1 will be charged an entry fee, coach fee and any other expenses associated with tournament separately. Another jotform will be sent closer to the time.

Fees are charged upon a student registering and being placed in a team. If a player decides to withdraw after being placed in a team they will still be liable for full payment. Bethlehem College has to commit to expenses associated with the teams once registrations are completed.
