# Volleyball

Fees are charged upon a student registering and being placed in a team. If a player decides to withdraw after being placed in a team, they will still be liable for full payment. Bethlehem College has to commit to expenses associated with the teams once registrations are completed.

### Kiwi Volley Y3-6

What is it: modified rules with 4 players per side on a badminton court with higher net Game venue: Memorial Hall (Small hall adjoined with QEYC) or Haumaru Sports & Rec Centre Playing dates: TBC – typically starts week 3 or 4 and continues for the duration of the term

Game times: FRIDAYS 4:00pm - 7:15pm

**Practices**: One day after school. Y3/4/5 330-4pm. Y6s 330-430pm in the BC Events Center **Coached by**: mix of junior athletes and parent volunteers with some volleyball experience

Cost: approx. \$60 per player

**Uniform**: BC PE gear and indoor runners. Kneepads are optional if your child tends to dive.

## **Intermediate Volleyball Y7-8**

Trials: We will hold trials in week 2 of term 1.

**Team info**: There will be an intermediate A team for boys and girls and depending on numbers our goal is to have an 8A and a 7A team for both boys and girls as well. Beyond that there will be social teams who will be parent led and will not have set training slots until we know the EC availability.

Game venue: QEYC or Haumaru Sports & Rec Centre

**Playing dates**: TBC – typically starts week 3 or 4 and continues for the duration of the term **Game times**: FRIDAYS between 4:00pm – 8:00pm. 40 minute games on full sized court with 6v6 and volleyball rules.

**Practices**: Times will be after school from 330-430/330-5/430-6pm depending on coach and court availability. The Intermediate A boys and girls teams will aim to have two practices per week. All other teams will have one training unless coaches and gym space are available for more. One of these trainings might be during lunchtime. All other teams will likely train during lunch. We are also looking at running a weekly development clinic for intermediate players to attend weekly as it has proven too hard to find experienced coaches for all the teams. This is to be confirmed and ideally would take place during lunch. If you have the capacity to coach with purpose and help grow our volleyball program please reach out to Jodi.

Cost: approx. \$80 per player

**Uniform**: BC PE gear and indoor court shoes.

**Coaches**: We are always in need of more coaches who know the game and for intermediates it's important to know the basics of how to pass, set, serve and where to stand on the court. If you are willing and able please let Jodi know.

#### **Junior Volleyball Y9-10**

Trials: Week 1-2 of term 1.

**Team info**: We are currently working on a format for term 1 as it is not the junior's competitive term,

but rather a time for them to gain foundations, skill and knowledge, with some game time mixed in with the weekly league. We are hoping to run a skill development clinic weekly for players to attend so they all have access to the same foundations regardless of whether their coach teaches it or not. Our plan will be to have the following teams selected for boys and girls: Junior A, 9A, 10A (potentially a fourth team depending on numbers) and that is it. These teams will have 1-2 trainings per week. Social teams will be parent-led and will not have guaranteed training slots until all other teams are slotted into the EC. Social players will have an opportunity to attend development clinics if we are able to put them into place.

**Playing dates**: TBC – typically starts week 2 or 3 and continues for the duration of the term **Game nights, locations & times**:

- Jr Girls and Boys competitive teams (JrA, 10A, 9A) will play on **Tuesday** nights @ Haumaru Sport Center or QEYC
- Jr Girls and Boys social teams can choose to play on **Wednesday** nights @ QEYC. BC will enter the teams but as mentioned above, they will be parent-led.

**Practices**: Between the hours of 330 and 730pm Monday - Friday depending on coaches and event center availability. 1.5-2h training slots once or twice a week.

**Cost**: approx. \$90 per player for social. Then depending on which team and league you play on/in the fee will be between \$100 - \$120 per player (based off last year).

**Uniform**: for league play teams can wear their PE uniform and runners.

### **Senior Volleyball**

**Trials** – all current (2025) y10-12 players welcome to trial. Boys trial is Dec 5<sup>th</sup> 330-5pm in the EC. Girls trial is Dec 8<sup>th</sup> 530-7pm.

Game venue: QEYC, Haumaru or Mercury Arean Baypark

**Playing dates**: Typically league games start in week 2-3 of term 1. Sr A boys and girls will have games starting in week one as per Bay Champs draw for home/away games.

**Game times**: THURSDAYS between 5:30pm – 930pm. Sr A boys and girls will not be playing in the Tauranga league. 11A and Sr B will be.

**Practices**: Sr A teams will have two trainings, one athlete development program (like S&C – to be confirmed though), and one-two games per week. 11A teams will likely have 2 trainings dependent on coach availability. Senior B teams will have 1-2 trainings as per coach availability as well.

**Cost**: approx. \$100-120 per player 11A/Snr B Teams (dependent if their team goes to Bay Champs or not). \$190 per player Snr A Team (based off last year). Senior A teams have summer tournament week which will be approximately

**Uniform**: PE uniform for non-competitive teams participating in the local league. Indoor court shoes to be worn for all trainings and games. Uniforms will be given to all teams competing at Bay champs.
