

Touch Rugby – Term 4 2026

Fees are charged upon a student registering and being placed in a team. If a player decides to withdraw after being placed in a team, they will still be liable for full payment. Bethlehem College has to commit to expenses associated with the teams once registrations are completed.

Game Venue: Mixed boy / girl teams on Tuesday nights at Gordon Spratt Reserve, Papamoa.

Playing dates: Tuesday League Dates TBC to Monday Date TBC 3.45pm to 6pm (Times may differ according to feedback from the Papamoa Touch League). Game Days are Tuesday Evenings for all age groups. No Games will be played on public holidays.

Teams: Teams will be formed by the sports coordinator in charge of Touch Rugby.

The sports office will be running trials where required for these teams with our dedicated coaches and selectors. Once teams are announced, there will be no changes to teams. There needs to be a minimum of 12 players and a maximum of 16 players in each team. The number of teams will be based on the registrations we receive and the number of players available for the season commitments. Any open spots in teams will be filled on the sports coordinator's discretion. Please be aware that we may not be able to accommodate all requests, and we will only be working with requests direct from parents, **NOT** from students.

Team Coaches: Please note all teams rely on parents' coaches and managers for each season. We cannot register the team into the league unless we have a confirmed parent coach and manager. We thank all parents in advance for their commitments.
